Raising Funds in aid of JAMES GRIBBLE



On a recent trip to Africa, James travelled to a remote island on the Zambezi River in Zambia to fish for the prized tiger fish. Following a long run James fainted while sitting on a stool, falling backwards and landing on his head on the hard sand. The result was catastrophic. James broke his C4 and C5 vertebrae and suffered severe bruising to his spinal cord. It resulted in severe spinal damage, leaving him a quadriplegic.

There are a number of events being undertaken to help raise some much needed funds for James' rehabilitation. Whilst donations are of course welcome and can be undertaken through the website www.puffinmagic.org.au – we are conscious of the demands on people's money during this credit crunch.

To offer something in return for a donation, we are organising a couple of events – a Leveraged Market Charity Golf Day in James' honour which is being supported by 20 teams and now an auction of prizes donated.

If you would like to bid for an item in the auction, this is the process:

STEP
1

Email me Barrie_williams@bankofscotland.co.uk with your starting bid for an item and the maximum bid you are willing to pay. There are minimum bids required for each item, although it should be noted that all proceeds go direct to the fund raising.

STEP
2

At the close of the auction (to be held on the afternoon of the Leveraged Market Golf Day on the 20th May 2010, your bid will be accepted and increased in £1 increments above any other bid for the item until the bid exceeds (or not) your maximum bid.

Example: You want to purchase the meal for 2 at Canteen and your opening bid is £75 and are willing to pay a maximum of £100.

Your bids	Competing bids
£75	£80
£86	£90
£91	£95
£96	£100

In this scenario – you lose as you have agreed not to go above £100. If the other bid was £99 then a final bid of £100 from you would win the item.

All clear? Then start bidding for some excellent items and a worthy cause.

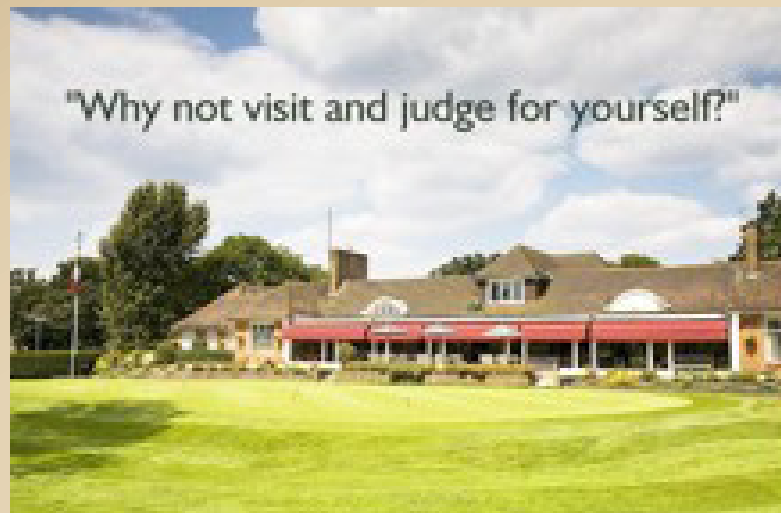

Langley Park golf course was designed by J.H.Taylor (one of the "triumvirate) who won the Open Championship on 5 occasions. It is a haven of peace and solitude which is surprising considering its close proximity to the centre of London. The course is set in 120 acres and measures 6453 off the medal tees with a par of 69 which provides an unrelenting, but fair, challenge to the serious golfer. The course has been used as an Open qualifier on numerous occasions and is well known for its exceptional greens.
